## The Invitatory Bead

From the rising of the sun to its setting  
let the Name of the Lord be praised.  
The Lord is high above all nations,  
and His glory above the heavens.

## The Cruciform Beads

O God, you will keep in perfect peace those whose minds  
and hearts are fixed on You and Your love; we pause in  
midday to rest and return to You.  
*(Pause for reflection; Journal your thoughts, if helpful.)*

## The Week Beads

In quietness and trust shall be our strength.

## Final Cruciform Bead

Your Light, O Lord, guides my way;  
Remind me of this throughout the day.  
*(Prayers for ourselves and others may follow.)*

## The Invitatory Bead

Our Father, who is in heaven; Hallowed be Your Name.  
Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in  
heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us  
our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.  
And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.  
For Yours is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory,  
forever and ever. Amen.

## The Cross
