The Cross

The Invitatory Bead

My sheep hear my voice. I know them, and they follow me.
I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one
will take them out of my hand. I am the Good Shepherd.

(John 10)

Cruciform 1 Bead

The Lord is my shepherd, I will not be in need.

Week 1 Beads

He brings me to green pastures; he leads me to still waters.
(Pause for reflection; Journal your thoughts, if helpful.)

Cruciform 2 Bead

He restores my soul.

Week 2 Beads

He leads me in right paths for his name's sake.
(Pause for reflection; Journal your thoughts, if helpful.)

Cruciform 3 Bead

Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I fear no
evil; for you are with me.

Week 3 Beads

Your rod and your staff – they comfort me.
(Pause for reflection; Journal your thoughts, if helpful.)

Cruciform 4 Bead

You prepare a table before me in the presence of my foes.

Week 4 Beads

You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.
(Pause for reflection; Journal your thoughts, if helpful.)

Cruciform 1 Bead

Surely your goodness and mercy shall follow me all the
days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord
forever. *(Pause for reflection; Journal your thoughts, if helpful.)*

The Invitatory Bead

They will hunger no more, and thirst no more; the sun will
not strike them, nor any scorching heat; for the Lamb at the
center of the throne will be their shepherd, and he will guide
them to springs of the water of life, and God will wipe away
every tear from their eyes. *(Rev. 17)*

The Cross
